Attending the Shelterbox Scavenger Hunt is a great way to fulfil many badge requirements for a number of different badges. If your Scouts take part in the bases during the event we envision they will cover the following badge criteria:

Creative Challenge – The Scavenger Hunt requires Scouts to be creative and a number of activities can count towards this challenge, why not complete Part 5 (use social media in a creative and safe way) during the event to share your adventure with others?

Skills Challenge – Part 5 (Three problem solving activities)

Personal Challenge – Why not encourage your Scouts to have one of their two personal challenges be to raise money for Shelterbox through this event.

World Challenge – Part 2 (Working with an external organisation is covered if you raise money for Shelterbox) and Part 9 (there will be a number activities based around the international issues during the event).

Taking part in the event can also count towards many aspects of the **Teamwork** and **Team Leader** challenge badges.

The **Fundraising Activity Badge** is a great badge to achieve in aid of Shelterbox, why not set your Scouts the challenge of raising enough to buy one Shelterbox before the event in May? Throughout the event at least one aspect of the **Global Issues Activity Badge** will be covered. Why not also encourage Scouts to take lots of photos during the event which can count towards the **Photographer Activity Badge**? Throughout the event there will be the chance to undertake traditional activities from other countries, this fulfils Part 2 of the International Activity Badge. The event is also a great way to engage your Scouts with the **Marketing and Public Relations Activity Badge**, why not get your Scouts to produce media which could be used internally within Scouting or externally to promote Scouting through this adventure to your local community?
